DIS FOR PRESSURE

We continue our series discussing techniques for implementing the 4 P's principle: placement, position, pressure and practice. Too tight of a grip and you will struggle to generate speed in your swing, too light and the ability to control the clubface may be compromised. When identifying the correct grip pressure, I suggest using the number scale. Start by gripping the club as tight as you can, this will be a ten, and then halve the pressure to a five. This will be a suitable pressure for most shots, tight enough the club won't fall out of your hands and the forearms are gently flexed.

BREAK INTO THE FEDERAL WORKFORCE WITH NAF

hile federal hiring is often slow and sometimes even frozen because of budget constraints, there is one source of federal hiring that remains quite consistent -- NAF employment.

Non-appropriated funds (NAF) employment is considered federal employment. However, it is different from federal civil service employment due to the source of money for salaries. Civil service positions are paid for by money appropriated by Congress. NAF money, on the other hand, is self-generated by day care facilities, bowling centers, golf courses, and other activities that use NAF employees, including most FSS facilities!

There are two types of NAF positions: "flexible" and "regular." Flexible employees have work schedules that depend on the needs of the activity. Flexible employees may work a minimum of zero hours to a maximum of 40 hours per week. In contrast, regular employees work between 20 and 40 hours a week, depending on position requirements.

Employees with flexible NAF positions are eligible for the following benefits and compensation: Overtime pay, shift differential, awards,

workers' compensation, and unemployment compensation. To understand more about the differences in flex and regular benefits, please check in at the NAF Human Resources offices. They can help find the right fit for you.

There are a wide variety of Force Support Squadron (FSS) facilities that utilize NAF positions. The CDC is one of the largest NAF hiring centers with many of the workers utilizing the flexible positions while working on furthering their education or as a stepping stone to a regular position. Some of the other facilities that offer both flexible and regular positions include:

Working at one of these programs can provide valuable experience and opportunities for advancement not only within the FSS but for federal civil service. One last benefit of applying for a NAF position with FSS is that the hiring process is usually much faster than non-NAF, or appropriated fund (AF) positions.
